Village Scout support for local communities suffering from human/elephant conflict - Lower Zambezi, Zambia

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Conservation needs

The communities living in the Chiawa Game Management Area (GMA) face the daily challenge of resource conflicts between human and wildlife populations (principally elephants), unstable incomes and vulnerability to seasonal fluctuations which leads to food insecurity, high poverty rates and a negative attitude towards both elephants and conservation activities in the area. In 2012, a survey in Chiawa found that whilst 70% respondents reported planting maize, only half of them (37%) reported harvesting any, due to human-wildlife conflict and unfavourable weather conditions¹.

The human-elephant conflict (HEC) in Chiawa poses a threat to elephant populations in the short term, as there is intense pressure on the Zambian wildlife authority to respond to HEC through 'problem animal control', as this is often seen as the only solution to conflict and field protection, elephants may be killed in order to appease tension between communities and wildlife authorities. The HEC in Chiawa also poses a long-term threat to elephants in the GMA and National Park as these animals are seen as aggressive and evil, and therefore efforts to conserve them are greeted with resentment.

The introduction of HEC Village Scout patrols within the communities is important in providing people with the opportunity to benefit from conservation efforts. The protection offered to fields through this project enables farmers an option to live alongside wildlife through conflict mitigation, rather than seeing problem animal control as the only option to curb HEC.

Goals and Objectives

Between January and December 2014, the IEF provided \$9,000 to CLZ in order to reduce human-wildlife conflict in the Chiawa GMA through the provision of Village Scout support to 9 villages in the communities affected by HEC. Through a constant presence during peak season (Jan-April 2014) and ongoing support for the rest of the year (May-December), CLZ looks to improve the communities' livelihoods and food security in the area. Tensions between wildlife and communities lead to negative attitudes towards wildlife, conservation, and in extreme cases, even 'revenge killing' of elephants and wildlife causing damage to property. By providing a ZAWA/CLZ Human-Elephant Conflict team to respond to property and crop raids, CLZ hope to reduce conflict and improve attitudes towards elephants and conservation in the GMA.

Describe any activities that differ from the original proposed actions and explain the reason for the change.

Each VS works 20 days per month in the field on patrol (Chiawa GMA or Lower Zambezi National Park). Of this remaining 10 days, 4 of these are spent at home, but still on 'Human-Wildlife Conflict' duty. This means that they may be called at any time to respond to incidents in the Chiawa GMA. These days are in addition to the formal wildlife protection



and human-elephant patrols that take place in Western Chiawa GMA. Therefore there were more Human-Wildlife Conflict man-days provided than listed in Figure 1.

The number of patrols in the Western Chiawa GMA exceeds the number funded by the IEF between May and December (27.1 total in 2014). This is because patrols are deployed in this area not only for HEC mitigation but for law enforcement, through anti-snaring patrols and in response to reports of illegal activity.

Describe the conservation outcomes for elephants, wildlife, habitat and human communities, and list major findings and accomplishments to date.

In October 2014, CLZ's community support team carried out a small 'impact assessment' on farmers in the affected area. See attached Appendix 2, which details the findings of the impact assessment. Some highlights from the impact assessment:

"Thanks to the Village Scouts, we feel comfortable to plant crops now" Falesi Kumwamwasa, Kusemwa

"The Scouts have worked hard" Ireen Kapesa, Mugurameno

Describe any problems discovered or occurring during this grant period

Due to the logistics and long distances between CLZ Base Camp and where the teams are based in the Western Chiawa GMA (around 1 or 3 hours by boat), there are difficulties in ensuring that all patrol tracks are marked and recorded by GPS. As patrol teams may be called on or deployed at short notice they may not take the GPS with them. If GPS batteries run flat, then new ones cannot be resupplied immediately – these need to be taken with the next available transport, which may be one or two days after the batteries run out. In addition we only supply one GPS per patrol on HWC however the teams break themselves up into groups of 2 to cover more conflict areas and therefore some groups do not have GPSs.

We faced problems placing the VS within villages – unfortunately, when teams may be stationed in their own villages, this may lead to problems where some may be discovered to be drinking or visiting their families whilst on duty. On two occasions this was found to be the case, whereby the scout leader (who was from the area) was replaced by another ZAWA officer who did not reside in the village, and therefore temptation was reduced. Of course this problem cannot be eliminated, but in a community meeting, CLZ and ZAWA management asked community members to play their part in reporting any misconduct and refrain from giving scouts alcohol whilst on duty.



Was your project successful? State short and long term goals that you are using to evaluate your accomplishments.

Short Term Goals

- *Number of Human-Elephant-Conflict (HEC) incidents causing property/physical damage in the Chiawa GMA reduced;*

As 2014 was the first year in which HEC is being formally recorded, it is difficult to compare number of HEC incidents between 2013 and 2014. Therefore this goal is based on anecdotal evidence from members of the community, who were served by the Village Scouts. A final report is being compiled of all HWC incidents in 2014, which will be ready in Q1 2015 and will be shared with the IEF when complete.

- *Improved harvests for farmers of the Chiawa GMA during 2014 farming season;*
- *Property/physical damage suffered as a result of HEC incidents reduced;*

See below for excerpts from the project impact assessment carried out in October 2014:

The respondents to the impact assessment (Appendix 2 - full results) indicate that the majority of those questioned had increased their harvest. In addition to the more formal assessment which indicates increased harvest, anecdotal evidence from farmers in the area also shows increased harvests and improved food security.

Long Term goals:

- Number of ‘problem’ elephants controlled in the Chiawa GMA reduced;
- Improved attitudes towards elephant conservation by population of the Chiawa GMA;
- Improved livelihoods due to consistently increased harvests in the GMA;

The impact assessment (Appendix 2) indicates that there have been improved harvests in this first year of VS patrols as the result of a combination of VS patrols and the use of chilli fences as introduced by CLZ’s Community Support Programme, in collaboration with [Awely](#).

There has also been a marked improvement in relations between CLZ, ZAWA and the community. This has been evident in direct feedback to CLZ staff from farmers with whom we have had little relationship prior. A clear indication for support to conservation initiatives was the offer from the headman of Chapanga Village for land to build Village Scout housing. Since 2013, CLZ and ZAWA have been struggling to gather support for a piece of land



allocated for this purpose (but still owned by the community) because communities did not see the value in Village Scouts. This does not mean that there has been unbridled support for conservation, with tensions still arising where elephants destroy fields, and mistrust arises where law enforcement operations take place.

The database on Human-Wildlife Conflict for 2014 has been filled out throughout the year and will be circulated to IEF once completed.

Based on this Project, what is the “next step” for this project and does it have implications for future conservation actions?

Thanks to this IEF grant, 2014 was the first year in which dedicated Human-Elephant Conflict scout patrols were deployed in the Chiawa GMA. The increased harvests, as well as the positive reception from the Chiawa community, demonstrated the important role which conflict mitigation has in achieving mitigation. The reception of farmers, who now view CLZ and ZAWA as supportive to the severe issues which they face when farming in the area, has been valuable in long term conservation – elephant conservation efforts in the area are less seen as ‘the enemy’. Support for Village Scouts to be allocated land to build houses and live full time in the community has been vocalized, and this is of great value for CLZ’s Village Scout programme. Thanks to IEF funding, we will continue to deploy HWC patrols in the peak months (January-April) 2015.

The full time presence of wildlife scouts in the area also has implications for law enforcement – whilst the majority of the community are subsistence farmers, there is illegal activity taking place in the area, with snaring and even elephant poaching occurring North of the communities. With a permanent scout presence, it is harder for this activity to go undetected, and with regular contact between farmers and VSs, information and reports can more easily be made.

Using this increased, regular contact between VS and community members, in 2015’s recently approved funding application, CLZ decided to harness the opportunity to improve education amongst farmers regarding HEC mitigation techniques. Despite many farmers growing up in areas where elephants are commonplace, many are not aware of elephant social structures, warning signs and may use methods to scare them which are ineffective and place themselves in danger, such as throwing rocks. In 2015, all Village Scouts will be trained in reading elephant behaviour by experts and techniques which farmers can undertake at low cost to increase protection of their harvests. Therefore in the course of carrying out their duty and responding to calls, VS can discuss techniques with farmers and explain the behaviour of the elephants they are seeing.

Village Scouts faced transport challenges early on in the project. With a target area of 10km of river frontage under the VS’ mandate, the scouts were travelling long distances by foot and therefore response times to specific incidents were at times, long. In response to this, CLZ sought extra funding to procure bicycles which could be used by scouts in the line of HEC duty. CLZ successfully secured funds from the African Wildlife Foundation, which were used to procure six ‘Buffalo Bikes’, allocated to patrol teams on duty and used in 2015.

Thanks to funding from the IEF, CLZ have been able to deploy Village Scout patrols in the Western Chiawa GMA, home to over 10,000 people, every month throughout 2014 in order to reduce human-elephant conflict. In this area where the majority of the community are subsistence farmers, human-wildlife conflict, specifically elephants, is a major threat to livelihoods, with fields and granary stores frequently destroyed. This causes animosity and anger towards wildlife and conservation efforts in the area, which is home to around 2,000 elephants that need vital protection. Thanks to IEF funding in 2014, CLZ were able to deploy to Village Scouts, in combination with the Zambia Wildlife Authority, to patrol two conflict 'hotspots' in Chiawa through the peak farming months, and as a result farmers have reported dramatically increased harvests, with some farmers being able to feed their families from their harvests for the first time in their living memory. The project has increased support for conservation efforts in the area, with communities now feeling supported by those carrying out wildlife protection.

Organizations associated with this project and their roles in the project:

Zambia Wildlife Authority: Since our establishment in 1994, CLZ have worked closely with ZAWA, and maintain a strong working relationship with the LZAMU Area Warden, Mr Moses Kaoma and Senior Operations Ranger Shadreck Silumesi. On a daily basis Chief Executive Officer, Ian Stevenson and Operations Manager Rabson Tembo update and communicate with the Warden with regards to activities in the LZNP and surrounding GMAs. Each scout deployment is carried out in consultation with ZAWA - deployment locations are decided with ranger Mr Silumesi. Each Village Scout team is led by a ZAWA Wildlife Police Officer from the operations base in Chirundu, and for these HWC deployments two were provided, one to lead the officer in the Gota Gota area and one in the Mugurameno area. All patrol tracks and reports are downloaded at CLZ Base Camp and shared with ZAWA through daily communications and monthly reports.

Community Resource Boards: CLZ, ZAWA and the Community Resource Boards are responsible for the management of the Village Scout unit (established 2013) and therefore work side by side on management of the unit including contracts, disciplinary issues and other HR issues. All teams are deployed as a result of CLZ/ZAWA collaboration and joint decisions on deployment location and movement.
